WHEREAS, CARES Inc., is a not-for-profit organization with expertise in the study and development of plans to prevent and end homelessness; and

WHEREAS, CARES Inc. contracted with the County of Columbia to study and develop a ten year plan with the goal to end homelessness within the County of Columbia; and

WHEREAS, after study and analysis, CARES Inc., presented a plan and recommendations to the Columbia County Board of Supervisors at a meeting conducted March 9, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the County of Columbia wishes to accept the CARES Inc., report and recommendations and move forward toward implementation of the recommendations therein within Columbia County;
