AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COLUMBIA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO EXECUTE A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$55,700.00 WITH RYAN-BIGGS ASSOCIATES PC OF CLIFTON PARK, NY FOR THE DESIGN OF A NEW CENTER PIER AND STREAM BANK RESTORATION AT MICHALUK BRIDGE, CARRYING MAPLE LANE OVER BASH BISH BROOK IN THE TOWN OF COPAKE

UPON, recommendation of the Public Works Committee at a meeting held on the 28th day of September 2011, of the Budget & Salary Review Committee at a meeting held on the 29th day of September 2011 and the Finance Committee at a meeting held on the 4th day of October 2011;

WHEREAS, Michaluk Bridge was closed to all traffic due to heavy damage by Hurricane Irene, with it's existing center pier destroyed and the upstream corridor heavily eroded/damaged; and

Whereas, Michaluk Bridge carries Maple Lane, which is a dead-end road with 3 residences located on the East Side of the Bash Bish Brook, and it is necessary to replace the destroyed center pier, restore the upstream Bash Bish Brook streambanks and re-open the bridge as soon as possible; and

WHEREAS, FEMA and NYS Funding will cover the Majority of the Design cost for this project in the amount of \$55,700.00;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Columbia County Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized to execute a Professional Services Agreement in the amount of \$55,700.00 with Ryan-Biggs Associates for the design of a new center pier and stream bank restoration at Michaluk Bridge carrying Maple Lane over Bash Bish Brook in the Town of Copake, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the above agreement is subject to review by the County Attorney's Office; and be it further

RESOLVED, that certified copies of this resolution be forwarded to the Engineering Department (8) certified copies, the Commissioner of Public Works, the Accounts Payable Department, the Columbia County Attorney and the Columbia County Treasurer.
