AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO DEDICATE ROUTE 11 BETWEEN NEW YORK STATE ROUTE 23 TO COUNTY ROUTE 27 IN THE TOWNS OF COPAKE AND TAGHKANIC AS THE BERNARD J. KELLEHER, SR. MEMORIAL HIGHWAY IN RECOGNITION OF MR. KELLEHER'S CONTRIBUTION TO COLUMBIA COUNTY IN HIS SERVICE AS COMMISSIONER OF PUBLIC WORKS BETWEEN THE YEARS OF 1956 TO 1977

UPON, recommendation of the Public Works Committee at a meeting held on the 23 day of November, 2011 and of the Finance Committee at a meeting held on the 6th day of December, 2011;

WHEREAS, this dedication is being made in consideration of the driving force provided by Commissioner Kelleher Sr. for the funding, design and construction of this County Highway; and
