**AUTHORIZATION FOR THE DIRECTOR OF COMMUNITY SERVICES TO OPEN
A SATELLITE OF THE CCDHS MHC AT THE JOHN L. EDWARDS PRIMARY
SCHOOL IN HUDSON ONE DAY A WEEK EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY**

UPON, recommendation of the Health/ Medical Services Committee at a meeting held on the 15th day of February 2011, the Budget and Salary Review Committee at a meeting held on the 23th day of February 2011, and the Finance Committee at a meeting held on the 1st day of March 2011;

WHEREAS, the Columbia County Department of Human Services (CCDHS) Mental Health Clinic (MHC) currently serves children and families at only one location; 325 Columbia Street, Hudson; and

WHEREAS, the CCDHS strives to enhance access to services; and

WHEREAS, the administration of the City of Hudson School District and specifically the John L. Edwards Primary School administration has requested the establishment of a MHC satellite located in their building; and

WHEREAS, the establishment of a satellite office of the MHC at the John L. Edwards Primary School will enhance access to services; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson School District has offered two rooms free of charge to the MHC to establish this satellite; and

WHEREAS, the CCDHS has submitted a proposal to the NYS Office of Mental Health (OMH) to establish a satellite clinic offering services one day a week at this site; and

WHEREAS, the NYS OMH has approved the above referenced proposal; and

WHEREAS, the CCDHS does not anticipate any increase in costs associated with this satellite; and

WHEREAS, the CCDHS anticipates the ability to receive additional net reimbursement for services provided at this site utilizing existing MHC staff;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT

RESOLVED, that the Director of Community Services is authorized to open a satellite of the CCDHS MHC at the John L. Edwards Primary School in Hudson one day/ week effective immediately; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the total estimated expenses are \$13,641.36 and the total estimated revenue is \$47,564.10; and be it further

RESOLVED, that once the figures are available, the Treasurer is authorized to make appropriate budget amendments; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this resolution is subject to review and approval of the Columbia County Attorney's office of documents and insurances; and be it further

RESLOVED, that certified copies of this resolution be forwarded to the Columbia County Human Resources Department, the Human Services/ Behavioral Health Center, the Payroll/ Accounts Payable Department, the Columbia County Attorney, and the Columbia County Treasurer.
