**AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF ELECTIONS TO DISPOSE OF APPROXIMATELY
54 NO-LONGER UTILIZED BALLOT BOXES**

UPON, recommendation of the County Government Committee at a meeting held on the 23rd day of February 2011; and of the Finance Committee at a meeting held on the 1st day of March 2011;

WHEREAS, the Columbia County Board of elections has for decades maintained in storage a great number of old wood or metal ballot boxes, which are no longer utilized but occupy a significant amount of storage space; and

WHEREAS, a great deal of more storage space is required for paper ballots and ancillary materials required for an optical scan voting process;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT

RESOLVED, that the Commissioners of the Board of Elections are hereby authorized to dispose of approximately 54 no longer used wooden and/or metal boxes; and be it further

RESOLVED. that certified copies of this resolution be forwarded to the Commissioners of BOE, the Columbia County Attorney and the Columbia County Treasurer.
