**RESOLUTION REORGANIZING THE OFFICE OF
THE COLUMBIA COUNTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY**

WHEREAS, the 2012 budget for Assistant District Attorneys has been reduced from the 2011 budget by 14.9%, from an amount of \$620,859 to an amount of \$528,175; and

WHEREAS, the terms of all Assistant District Attorneys have expired as of the end of the calendar year 2011; and

WHEREAS, the newly elected District Attorney is desirous of making an efficient use of those resources allocated by the Board of Supervisors, and with the appointments of new Assistant District Attorneys has re-structured the office; and

WHEREAS, the District Attorney shall require a Court Attendant to assist with Grand Jury, *inter alia* and has agreed with the Columbia County Sheriff that the Sheriff will provide same on a part-time basis, provided his department is reimbursed;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT

RESOLVED, that the District Attorney, in accordance with New York State County law section 700 *et. seq.* has created and shall fill the positions of Assistant District Attorneys within the limits of the budget, \$528,175, with such full and part-time attorneys as follows:

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution shall apply to titles of Assistant District Attorney within the Office of the District Attorney, said former Assistant District Attorney positions and titles are hereby abolished, with no effect on non-union or support personnel except as herein mentioned, and the above positions of Assistant District Attorney are created and filled as above stated, to be effective January 1, 2012, said positions shall not be subject to the 15%/10%/5% salary reduction and shall be eligible for health insurance coverage immediately upon hire, further that the salary reduction shall not apply and immediate health insurance shall be available to the Confidential Secretary Lisa Bleau; and be it further.

RESOLVED, that the treasurer is authorized to transfer the sum of \$18,175 to the Budget of the Columbia County Sheriff for reimbursement, and be it further

RESOLVED, that certified copies of this resolution be forwarded to the District Attorney, the named appointees, Human Resources, Accounts Payable/Payroll, Civil Service, Columbia County Attorney and Columbia County Treasurer.
