**AMENDED AUTHORIZATION TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT BETWEEN  
COLUMBIA COUNTY AND NY AND SOLID BENEFIT GUIDANCE, LLC (SBG)**

UPON, recommendation of the Finance Committee at a meeting held on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of February 2012;

WHEREAS, on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2011, the Board of Supervisors passed a resolution, No.: 405-2011, authorizing a contract by and between the County of Columbia and Solid Benefit Guidance, LLC (“SBG”) whereby for a fee of \$15,000 SBG estimated it could produce a 10% savings in the annual cost of prescriptive drugs to the County, and

WHEREAS, concerns were raised after resolution No.: 405-2011 was passed with SBG that a clause guaranteeing a rebate of their fee were not included in the contract, and

WHEREAS, after further discussion with SBG it was determined that they will guarantee a 10% savings in the annual cost of prescriptive drugs to the County, not including any litigation fees as a result of a breach of contract with ProAct, or they will refund the County their \$15,000 fee;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT**

**RESOLVED**, this resolution amends resolution No.: 405-2011; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that authorization be given to enter into contract between Columbia County, NY and SBG, whereby SBG guarantees a 10% savings in the annual cost of prescriptive drugs to the County, not including any litigation fees as a result of a breach of contract with ProAct; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that this contract, in its amended form, is subject to approval by the County Attorney’s Office; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that authority is given to the Columbia County Controller to execute this contract on behalf of the County; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that certified copies of this resolution be forwarded to the Columbia County Human Resources Department, the Payroll/ Accounts Payable Department, the Columbia County Controller, the Columbia County Attorney, and the Columbia County Treasurer.
