**AUTHORIZATION TO APPROVE THE RESTRUCTURING PROPOSAL OF THE
COLUMBIA-GREENE WORKFORCE INVESTMENT BOARD FROM 38
MEMBERS TO 34 MEMBERS**

UPON, recommendation of the Human Services Committee at a meeting held on the 21st day of March 2012; and of the Finance Committee at a meeting held on the 3rd day of April, 2012;

WHEREAS, the proposal allows for continued representation from partners while reducing membership to increase efficiency and strengthen involvement; and

WHEREAS, the proposal eliminates the annual alternating appointments of members, which has proven challenging and confusing for partner representative and the Board as a whole; and

WHEREAS, the counties would split the responsibility of making appointments for four (4) Representative organizations and would reassign representation responsibilities for other organizations;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT

RESOLVED, that the Columbia County Board of Supervisors hereby accepts the Columbia-Greene Workforce Investment Board proposal to restructure the Board from 38 members to 34 members; and be it further

RESOLVED, that certified copies of the resolutions be forwarded to Katy Drake, Consulting Director of the Columbia Greene WIB, the Columbia County Attorney and the Columbia County Treasurer.
