AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COLUMBIA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO EXECUTE A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH BARTON & LOGUIDICE, PC OF ALBANY, NY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$38,700.00 FOR ENGINEERING ASSESSMENT, FIELD INSPECTION, FLAG ANALYSIS, STRUCTURAL DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION SUPPORT SERVICES FOR ELEMENT-SPECIFIC REPAIRS TO FIVE (5) COUNTY BRIDGES, FUNDING WILL BE 100% COUNTY COST

UPON, recommendation of the Public Works Committee at a meeting held on the 28th day of March, 2012; of the Budget & Salary Review Committee at a meeting held on the 29th day of March, 2012; and of the Finance Committee at a meeting held on the 3rd day of April, 2012;

WHEREAS, several county bridges are in need of repairs to certain bridge elements/components Or have received structural flags from NYSDOT recently and the count has deemed it necessary to undertake the design and eventual construction of the necessary bridge repairs later this year,; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Columbia County Board of Supervisors is hereby Authorized to execute a Professional Services Agreement with Barton & Loguidice, PC of Albany, NY in the amount of \$38,700.00 for Engineering Assessment, Field Inspection, Flag Analysis, Structural Design and construction Support Services for element-specific repairs to Five (5) County Bridges, funding is 100% County cost; and be if further

RESOLVED, that several county bridges are in need of repairs to certain bridge elements/components Or have received structural flags from NYSDOT recently and the count has deemed it necessary to undertake the design and eventual construction of the necessary bridge repairs later this year,; and be it further

RESOLVED, that certified copies of this resolution be forwarded to the Engineering Department (6 certified copies), the Commissioner of Public Works, the Accounts Payable Department, the Columbia County Attorney and the Columbia County Treasurer.
