RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COLUMBIA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO EXECUTE A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH WILLIAM STANWYCK III OF STANWYCK AVIONICS, INC. FOR THE PREPARATION OF A FAA-APPROVED AND COMPLIANT AIRPORT SNOW/ICE CONTROL PLAN, INCLUDING ASSOCIATED AIRPORT VEHICLE OPERATIONS AND COMMUNICATION TRAINING AT A COST OF \$1,500.00

UPON, recommendation of the Public Works Committee at a meeting held on the 25th day of April 2012, and of the Finance Committee at a meeting held on the 1st day of May 2012;

WHEREAS, the Columbia County Airport is required by the Federal Aviation Administration to have in place an Airport Snow & Ice Control Plan specific to our facility and these professional services are necessary to assist the County in complying with this FAA Directive;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Columbia County Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized to execute a Professional Services Agreement with William Stanwyck III of Stanwyck Avionics, Inc. for the preparation of a FAA-Approved and compliant airport Snow/Ice control Plan, including associated airport vehicle operations and communication training at a cost of \$1,500.00; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the above agreement is subject to the approval by the Columbia County Attorney's Office; and be it further

RESOLVED, that certified copies of this resolution be forwarded to the Engineering Department (6 certified copies), the Commissioner of Public Works, the Accounts Payable Department, the Columbia County Attorney and the Columbia County Treasurer.
