**AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF A SURPLUS COUNTY

UPON, recommendation of the Finance Committee at a meeting held on the 3rd day of July, 2012;

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has determined that a 2001 Chevrolet Tahoe owned by the County and previously used by the Sheriff's Department is no longer useful and necessary for public use by the Sheriff's Department; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to County Law §215(9) and County Code 179, the Board of Supervisors is authorized to sell or otherwise dispose of county personal property no longer necessary for public use; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson has expressed a need for an additional vehicle, and is willing to take, service and further utilize said 2001 Chevrolet Tahoe;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT

RESOLVED, that the Columbia County Sheriff Department is hereby authorized to effectuate a transfer of a 2001 Chevrolet Tahoe VIN: 1GNEK13V81J257083, to the City of Hudson; and be it further

RESOLVED, that certified copies of this resolution be forwarded to the Columbia County Sheriff, the County Clerk, the Mayor of the City of Hudson, the Columbia County Attorney and the County Treasurer.
