**AUTHORIZING THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT
WITH NYS DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES FOR ACCESS TO DATA SHARING
SYSTEMS FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT**

UPON, recommendation of the Public Safety Committee at a meeting held on the 18th day of October 2012; and of the Finance Committee at a meeting held on the 5th day of November, 2012;

WHEREAS, Governor Andrew Cuomo announced a new initiative expanding the Department of Motor Vehicles services for law enforcement in partnership with the Division of Criminal Justice Services, to allow the Sheriff's Office to enter into an agreement with NYS DMV to access data sharing systems for law enforcement;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT

RESOLVED, that the Sheriff's Office is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the NYS Department of Motor Vehicles for access to data sharing systems for law enforcement; and be it further

RESOLVED, that Governor Andrew Cuomo announced a new initiative expanding the Department of Motor Vehicles services for law enforcement in partnership with the Division of Criminal Justice Services, requesting authorization for the Sheriff's Office to enter into an agreement with NYS DMV to access data sharing systems for law enforcement; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this agreement is subject to the approval of the County Attorney's Office; and be it further

RESOLVED, that certified copies of this resolution be forwarded to the Columbia County Sheriff's Office, the Accounts Payable Department, the Human Resources Department, the Columbia County Attorney and the Columbia County Treasurer.
