**AUTHORIZATION FOR THE HUMAN SERVICES DEPARTMENTEN TO FILL 1.0 FTE  
VACANT BUDGETED BEHAVIORAL HEALTH CARE COORDINATOR**

UPON, recommendation of the Health and Medical Services Committee at a meeting held on the 16th day of April 2013; of the Budget and Salary Review Committee at a meeting held on the 25th day of April 2013; and of the Finance Committee at a meeting held on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of April 2013;

WHEREAS, the CCDHS Civil Service Commission and UPSEU have agreed to backfill existing vacated Targeted Case Management (TCM) positions with a new “Behavioral Health Care Coordinator” title (GR 15 – Grade Salary \$48,259.00) to reflect the NYS OMH/DOH conversion from TCM to Care Coordination reimbursement and service delivery models; and

WHEREAS, the Columbia County Board of has approved Resolution No. 413-2012 supporting the above referenced change; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Human Service (DHS) has had 2.0 FTE’s of vacant BHCC since December 28, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the DHS has a substantially vetted viable candidate to fill One (1) FTE BHCC vacancy; and

WHEREAS, the DHS receives reimbursement for services rendered for the above position at 80% of the position’s salary and fringe costs; and

WHEREAS, failing to fill this position expeditiously will result in prolonged lack of service to vulnerable children and adults waiting for service;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT**

**RESOLVED**, that the DHS is hereby authorized to fill 1.0 FTE replacement “TCM” position of the newly Civil Service Commission adopted GR 15 (annual base salary \$48,259.00) Behavioral Health Care coordinator title pending successful vetting; waiving the 15%, 10%, 5% salary reduction requirement (as per UPSEU agreement and Resolution No. 413-2012) utilizing the emergency hire process to expedite the vacancy pending successful vetting; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, these positions are budgeted and the appointments will be provisional pending the Civil Service Exam; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that certified copies of this resolution be forwarded to the Department of Human Services, the Human Resources Director, the Civil Service Commission, the Payroll Department, the Columbia County Attorney and the Columbia County Treasurer.
