DECLARING THE EXISTING 2.1 GHZ HOP FROM THE PUBLIC SAFETY BUILDING TO BLUE TOWER AS SURPLUS AND TO AUTHORIZE THE SALE TO ACCEPT THE HIGHEST QUALIFIED BIDDER AND TO AWARD THE BID

UPON, recommendation of the Public Safety Committee at a meeting held on the 18th day of April 2013 and of the Finance Committee at a meeting held on the 30th day of April 2013;

WHEREAS, the Point to Point communications equipment from the Public Safety Building to Blue tower is no longer needed; and

WHEREAS, the existing 2.1 GHz hop has been declared surplus and authorization is given to Director Robert Lopez to accept the highest qualified bidder if any, and award the sale subject at a minimum bid of \$25,000; and

WHEREAS, AT&T was the sole bidder at the minimum bid of \$25,000.00

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT

RESOLVED, that the Director of 911 is hereby authorized to declare the point to point communications equipment, the existing 2.1Ghz hop from the Public Safety Building to Blue tower as surplus and to award the bid to AT&T being the sole bidder at the minimum bid of \$25,000; and be it further

RESOLVED, that certified copies of this resolution be forwarded to Director of 911, the Accounts Payable Department, the Columbia County Attorney and the Columbia County Treasurer.
