WHEREAS, In recognition of his outstanding dedication, commitment, and spirit of service to the constituents of the 41st Senate District of New York State, the Columbia County Board of Supervisors is honored to recognize Senator Stephen M. Saland of Poughkeepsie, New York for his service to the residents of Columbia County, New York; and

WHEREAS, Senator Stephen M. Saland has dedicated over 36 years of public service, first serving as an town councilman in Dutchess County, serving in the State Assembly from 1980 through 1990 and served as Columbia Counties 41st District Senator from 1990 through 2012; and
