**AUTHORIZATION TO FILL 1.0 FTE VACANT BUDGETED BEHAVIORAL  
HEALTH CARE COORDINATOR (BHCC)**

UPON, recommendation of the Health/Medical Services Committee at a meeting held on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2013; of the Budget & Salary Review Committee at a meeting held on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of May, 2013 and of the Finance Committee at a meeting held on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2013;

WHEREAS, the Department of Human Services (DHS) has had 1.0 FTE vacant BHCC since 2/2013; and

WHEREAS, the DHS has a substantially vetted viable candidate to fill one 1.0 FTE BHCC vacancy; and

WHEREAS, the DHS receives reimbursement for services rendered; and

WHEREAS, the above referred funding supports ~ 80% of the position's salary and fringe costs; and

WHEREAS, failing to fill this position expeditiously will result in prolonged lack of service to vulnerable children and families waiting for service;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT**

**RESOLVED** that the DHS is authorized to fill 1.0 FTE Grade 15 (base annual salary \$48,259.00) Behavioral Health Care Coordinator title pending successful vetting; waiving the 15%,10%, 5% salary reduction requirement (as per UPSEU agreement and resolution #413-2012) utilizing the emergency hire process to expedite filling the vacancy. These positions are budgeted and the appointments will be provisional pending the results of the Civil Service Exam; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that certified copies of this resolution be forwarded to the Department of Human Services, the Payroll Department, the Human Resources Department, the Civil Service Commission, the Columbia County Attorney and the Columbia County Treasurer.
