AUTHORIZING TRADING PARTNER AGREEMENTS FOR EARLY INTERVENTION AND THE PRESCHOOL PROGRAM

UPON, recommendation of the Health/Medical Services Committee at a meeting held on the 15th day of January 2013 and the Finance Committee at a meeting held on the 5th day of February 2013;

WHEREAS, the NYSDOH Bureau of Early Intervention has created a web-based program called NYEIS for electronic billing; and

WHEREAS, a trading partner agreement must be in place between the county and providers in order for providers to electronically exchange information and data in connection with certain early intervention transactions concerning billing for services rendered to children and their families;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT

RESOLVED, that that the Director will be given authority to engage in and sign all Trading Partner Agreements with all appropriate providers who will be, or are required to, bill electronically for the time period commencing now through June 30, 2013; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this resolution shall be re-authorized annually thereafter; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Unity House of Troy and Capital District Beginnings be approved for said agreement; and be it further

RESOLVED, that any contract entered into is subject to approval by the County Attorney's Office; and be it further

RESOLVED, that certified copies of this resolution be forwarded to the Department of Health, the Accounts Payable Department, the Columbia County Attorney and the Columbia County Treasurer.
