SERVICES OFFICE FOR INTEROPERABLE AND EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS**

**UPON, recommendation of the Public Safety Committee at a meeting held on the 19th day of
September 2013 and of the Finance Committee at a meeting held on the 25th day of September, 2013;**

**WHEREAS, the Communication Assets Survey and Mapping (CASM) Tool provides NYS
Public Safety Officials with a means to gather and analyze communications systems data to identify
and to improve emergency response communications;**

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT

**RESOLVED, that the Director of 911 is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with New
York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services Office of Interoperable and
Emergency communications for the use of a Communication Assets Survey and Mapping tool (CASM)
with no cost to the County; and be it further**

Office; and be it further**

**RESOLVED, that certified copies of this resolution be forwarded to the Director of 911, the
Columbia County Attorney and the Columbia County Treasurer.**
