**AUTHORIZING COLUMBIA COUNTY TO REDUCE THE PRESCRIPTION DRUG
COVERAGE PREMIUM EQUIVALENT**

UPON, recommendation of the Insurance Committee at a meeting held on the 24th day of October 2013 and of the Finance Committee at a meeting held on the 24th day of October 2013;

WHEREAS, the County self-insures prescription drug coverage for active employees with the Pharmacy Benefit Manager Pro-Act managing scripts and CanaRx providing a less expensive alternative for brand name drugs, and

WHEREAS, each year it is required that the County estimate how much prescription drug costs are going to be and divide that by the number of enrolled to establish a “premium equivalent”;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT

RESOLVED, that authorization is given for Columbia County to reduce the Premium Equivalent for Drug Coverage equivalent from the current rate of \$120/month to \$110/month for individual, from \$250/month to \$220/month for a two person contract, and the \$350/month rate for family will remain the same per the attachment effective January 1, 2014; and be it further

RESOLVED, that any agreement entered into is subject to approval by the County Attorney's office; and be it further

RESOLVED, that certified copies of this resolution be forwarded to the Human Resources Department, the Controller’s Department, the Columbia County Attorney and the Columbia County Treasurer.
