AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COLUMBIA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO EXECUTE A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT (SUPPLEMENT #1) TO THE 2012 MULTI-BRIDGE ENGINEERING DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION SUPPORT PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT (ORIGINAL CO. CONTRACT #C-116-12, DATE 4/28/12) BETWEEN COLUMBIA COUNTY AND BARTON & LOGUIDICE, PC OF ALBANY NY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$6,700.00 FOR DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION SUPPORT SERVICES NECESSARY FOR THE EMERGENCY REPAIR OF A NYSDOT RED-FLAGGED SCOUR CONDITION AT COLUMBIA COUNTY BRIDGE BIN # 3342350, CARRYING COUNTY RTE. 25/FITTING CREEK IN THE TOWN OF STOCKPORT

UPON, recommendation of the Public Works Committee at a meeting held on the 23rd day of January 2013; of the Budget and Salary Review Committee at a meeting held on the 24th of January 2013 and of the Finance Committee at a meeting held on the 5th day of February 2013;

WHEREAS, an immediate response was required by the County DPW to immediately address The red flaf issued by NYSDOT in December 2012 for scour and undermining at the Little Creek Bridge and said necessary immediate design services were able to be acquired from and added on to the still active 2012 County Multi- Bridge repair design contract and adequate funds are available within the 2012 County Bridge Force Account (H15E51114000E4000)

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Columbia County Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized to execute a professional services agreement (Supplement #1) to the 2012 multi-bridge engineering design and construction support professional services contract (original co. contract #C-116-12, date 4/28/12) between Columbia County and Barton & Loguidice, PC of Albany NY in the amount of \$6,700.00 for design and construction support services necessary for the emergency repair of a NYSDOT red-flagged scour condition at Columbia County Bridge Bin # 3342350, carrying County Rte. 25/Fitting Creek in the Town of Stockport; and be it further

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RESOLVED, that this services agreement is subject to the approval of the County Attorney's Office; and be it further

RESOLVED, that certified copies of this resolution be forwarded to the Engineering Dept. (6 certified copies), the Accounts Payable Department, the Commissioner of Public Works, the Columbia County Attorney and the Columbia County Treasurer.
