AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COLUMBIA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO APPROVE THE ADDITION OF EXTRA WORK REQUIRED FOR THE EMERGENCY RED FLAG REPAIR WORK AT THE COLUMBIA COUNTY BRIDGE BIN # 3342350 COUNTY RTE 25 FITTING CREEK IN THE TOWN OF STOCKPORT TO THE ORIGINAL 2012 COUNTY MULTI-BRIDGE REPAIR CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT (ORIGINAL CO. CONTRACT # C-228-12, DATED 9-21-12) BETWEEN ARCH BRIDGE CONTRACTING CORP. OF ALTAMONT NY AND COLUMBIA COUNTY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$36,500.00

UPON, recommendation of the Public Works Committee at a meeting held on the 23rd day of January 2013; of the Budget and Salary Review Committee at a meeting held on the 24th of January 2013 and of the Finance Committee at a meeting held on the 5th day of February 2013;

WHEREAS, an immediate response was required by the County DPW to immediately address the red flag issued by NYSDOT in December 2012 for scour and undermining at the Little Creek Bridge and said necessary immediate flag work was able to be acquired from and added on to the still active 2012 County Multi-Bridge Repair Construction Contract as extra work and adequate funds are available within the 2012 County Bridge Force Account (H15E5114000E4000)

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT

RESOLVED, authorizing the Chairman of the Columbia County Board of Supervisors to approve the addition of extra work required for the emergency red flag repair work at the Columbia County Bridge Bin # 3342350 County RTE 25 Fitting Creek in the Town of Stockport to the original 2012 County Multi-Bridge Repair Construction Contract (original co. contract # c-228-12, dated 9-21-12) between Arch Bridge Contracting Corp. of Altamont, NY and Columbia County in the amount of \$36,500.00; and be it further

RESOLVED, an immediate response was required by the County DPW to immediately address the red flag issued by NYSDOT in December 2012 for scour and undermining at the Little Creek Bridge and said necessary immediate flag work was able to be acquired from and added on to the still active 2012 County Multi-Bridge Repair Construction Contract as extra work and adequate funds are available within the 2012 County Bridge Force Account (H15E5114000E4000); and be it further
