**AUTHORIZING THE ABANDONMENT OF A PARCEL OF LAND
ENTITLED BLUE STORES TO LIVINGSTON STATE HIGHWAY
NO. 5004 IN THE TOWN OF LIVINGSTON**

UPON, recommendation of the Public Works Committee at a meeting held on the 27th day of February 2013;

WHEREAS, the County of Columbia is the record owner of a parcel of vacant land in the Town of Livingston identified as Blue Stores to Livingston State Highway No. 5004 in the Town of Livingston on the attached Map; and

WHEREAS, Highway Law Article 8 §205 provides for the abandonment of all or portion of a County Highway which is no longer necessary for public travel; and

WHEREAS, the section of Blue Stores to Livingston State Highway No. 5004 was previously abandoned to the County of Columbia; and

WHEREAS, said section of Blue Stores to Livingston State Highway No. 5004 is determined to be no longer necessary for public travel; and

WHEREAS, the County of Columbia has been requested by the adjacent landowner to formally abandon said parcel of land; and

WHEREAS, the County of Columbia Highway Superintendent has requested that the County of Columbia consent to the abandonment of the aforesaid section of highway;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Columbia County Board of Supervisors be and hereby is authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to abandon said parcel to the adjoining landowner(s) for the purpose of taking title to said parcel in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00); and be it further

RESOLVED, that certified copies of this resolution be forwarded to the Accounts Payable Department, the Columbia County Attorney and the Columbia County Treasurer.
