A local law: ESTABLISHING THE SALARIES OF CERTAIN OFFICERS IN THE
 COUNTY OF COLUMBIA PURSUANT TO SECTION 201 OF THE COUNTY
 LAW AND SECTION 24(2)(h) OF THE MUNICIPAL HOME RULE LAW

Be It enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the

County City Town Village

of Columbia as follows:

Retroactive to January 1, 2013, that the annual salaries or portion thereof to be paid by the County of Columbia to the following County Officers shall be as set forth hereinafter, subject to permissive referendum as required by Section 24 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, where applicable:

Coroner (3)	\$ 13,246.59 (each)
County Clerk	\$ 70,160.00
Election Commissioner (2)	\$ 25,000.00 (each)
Commissioner of Social Services	\$ 91,617.58
Commissioner of Public Works	\$ 103,868.38
Director of Real Property Tax Services	\$ 61,784.95

Be it further enacted, that this Local Law shall be effective immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State. Where applicable, in the event that a petition is duly filed and a referendum held, this Local Law shall take effect after said referendum has been duly passed by a majority of the voters and filed with the Secretary of State, retroactive to January 1, 2013.
